	HEAD START						<p>NOTE: Applications should be completed for all pregnant mothers as well as age-eligible children, regardless of income.</p> <p>Participants are considered income eligible for Head Start/Early Head Start if their income falls below the poverty guidelines. Families at 101-130% of poverty and higher can only be enrolled if no income eligible participants are on the wait list. A maximum of 10% of total funded enrollment slots may be filled with families over the 130% of poverty range.</p>
