

## St. Clair Community Trust Theme Definitions

1. **Active Community:** A community in which numerous/various recreational opportunities are available to all residents of the community.

3. **Connected Community:** A community with facilities and online resources for people to come together and/or share information; a place where people can get to know one another better.)
4. **Educated Community:** A community that offers education, job training, and personal/professional development opportunities for residents of all ages.
5. **Engaged Community:** A community where residents of all ages have opportunities to volunteer and to work together to positively impact the lives of its residents; and where community members can come together to make decisions for the benefit of the community.
6. **Entrepreneurial Community:** A community with an active “main street” [and thriving culture] where job opportunities are plentiful, where small business can thrive, and where investments are made in infrastructure to support an innovative and inclusive economy.
7. **Family-Oriented Community:** A community where families are able to thrive by accessing [cultural and entertainment opportunities] as well as family-oriented and family-focused resources and services.
8. **Healthy Community:** A community where mental and physical health, including food/nutrition, resources and services are readily available and accessible to all residents.
9. **Safe Community:** A community with abundant, quality housing where people can live, work, walk, drive, and play without concern for crime, environmental hazards, or other dangers that may harm or damage a resident or his/her property.
10. **Well-Built Community:** A community in which there is a solid housing, transportation, and utility and technology infrastructure in place to support local living, local businesses, and community growth.
